

While we were seeing the success and impact of She Leads right in front of our eyes, we never stopped looking for potential opportunities to expand and grow our empowerment reach. How did we do this? By utilizing none other than a women's best weapon and greatest accessory: the scrunchie. A scrunchie is not only a possible source of revenue to sustain our She Leads initiative, but a symbol of our mission. We are currently exploring the possibility of outsourcing our manufacturing to vulnerable women in order to provide them with a stable, fair income.

Refined

Our vision is to eliminate landfill-waste of single-use coffee cups by writing a different ending to the story. Closing the loop by selling them as a raw textile. Imagine a world where every coffee cup you hold does not have to end up in a landfill, but is seen as a sustainably sourced raw material, a commodity. Our objective is that our fiber is used for various textiles in the fashion and home textiles industry, both as fabric and padding. We are also in the process of developing the fiber to suit e.g. wipes, filters, packaging, and medical textiles



Skill Series is a brand new project under Enactus Ontario Tech aiming towards educating students on campus with skills revolving around design, financial literacy, public speaking, leadership and personal growth. Last year we successfully ran 3 workshops on the topics of photoshop, photography and financial planning which were completely free for students to attend.


